SUMMARY STATEMENT: Funding for the purchase of pedestrian lights, benches and trash receptacles for the Honor Garden has been approved by the Council through revised FY02 Capital Improvement Budget. This memorandum is to inform the Council that 14 pedestrian lights, 20 benches and 2 trash receptacles are being purchased. A specific type of pedestrian light, bench and trash receptacle have been designated in the master plan for the garden. Therefore the purchase of these materials is a sole source. The pedestrian lights are being purchased through Husky Electric at a cost of 13,993.00. The benches and trash receptacles are being purchased directly through the manufacturer at a cost of 15,705.00.

STAFF RECOMMENDED ACTION: It is recommended that Council award purchase of the pedestrian lights, benches and trash receptacles for the Honor Garden.
