SUMMARY STATEMENT: Evangelos Restaurant currently holds a *non-transferable* liquor license that allows them to serve beer and wine on site. If the owner wishes to sell his restaurant this license would cease to exist.

Due to the City's population growth in 2003, a *transferable* beer and wine license is now available through the Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Board. Evangelos Restaurant has applied for this license, and if granted their current license is automatically void.

Pursuant to AS 04.11.480 the council may protest the approval of a liquor license application by furnishing the ABC Board and the applicant with a clear and concise written statement of reasons in support of their protest.

STAFF RECOMMENDED ACTION: To direct the clerk to send a letter of non objection to the ABC Board regarding the restaurant/eating place license for Evangelos Restaurant.
