SUMMARY STATEMENT:

In accordance with WMC 16.36.070.B, please be advised that on March 2, 2004, an appeal was received from Vision Investments, LLC regarding a decision on the following:

Elevation of Administrative Approval of Land Use Permit Application for the use of a portion of the existing 20,000 square feet of a commercial building located at 700 N. Wasilla-Fishhook Road on Lots 18–22, Block 2, Parks Manor Subdivision as a Teen Center. These parcels are zoned C-Commercial (Previously Planning Case No.: C04-81)

The mayor and I have solicited the following persons who are willing to serve as hearing officer:

Dave Chappel Don Moore, alternate Don Bennett, alternate Based upon those interested, Mayor Keller recommends Dave Chappel, as the hearing officer for this case. If for any reason Mr. Chapel cannot serve or becomes disqualified, the clerk will work with the mayor to select another person to serve on this case from the list of persons above.
