SUMMARY STATEMENT: This is a state contract vehicle purchase from Nye Frontier Ford of two new Public Works vehicles as was approved in the FY06 Wasilla Department of Public Works vehicle fund budget. The vehicles will be equipped and priced as follows:

- One (1) – 2006 Ford F350 Regular Cab Single Rear Wheel Drive (SRW) 4x4 pickup
 White in color, 8' bed, spray in bed liner, Class V trailer tow package
 Vinyl bench seat, 5.4L-V8 gas engine, automatic transmission, 4-wheel
 ABS, AM/FM radio, block heater.
 \$18,720.00

- One (1) – 2006 Ford F350 Extended Cab (SRW) 4x4 pickup
 White in color, 6.5' bed, spray in bed liner, Class V trailer tow package
 Vinyl bench seat, 5.4L-V8 gas engine, automatic transmission, 4-wheel
 ABS, AM/FM radio, block heater.
 \$20,647.00

both the Roads and Sewer/Water divisions. The F350 Regular Cab pickup is for the Roads Division and the Extended Cab pickup is for the Sewer/Water Division.

Per the State of Alaska State Equipment Fleet (SEF) policy, "SEF maintains contracts with several light duty vendors in Alaska. Each of these vendors supplies pricing for basic vehicles with additional cost for added options. SEF uses the pricing data listed to select a vendor for each individual vehicle purchase. The vendor who provides the vehicle at the lowest price will be awarded the purchase order. Per the attached 2006 vendor pricing list for Class 146 (1-ton extended cab, SRW, 4x4 pickup) and Class 162 (1-ton regular cab, SRW, 4x4 pickup), Nye Frontier Ford was the low cost bidder. Upon verbal review with Ed Dodd, Alaska Sales and Service – Valley, and Steve Johnson, Chevrolet of Wasilla, neither vendor was able to meet or beat the SEF price.

A thorough search was conducted to locate two similar low mileage, good condition vehicles on the used market; however, none could be acquired for a dollar amount that was less than the SOA new vehicle contract price.

STAFF RECOMMENDED ACTION: Council is requested to authorize the contract award for the purchase of two (2) new Department of Public Works vehicles from Nye Frontier Ford in the amount of \$39,367.
