SUMMARY STATEMENT: The attached proposal details work that is needed to provide the oversight required by FAA. The Phase1C Apron and Short Takeoff and Landing (STOL) runway construction budget is \$3.3 million. The construction administration proposal is 9 percent of the construction budget, which is typical for this type of work. FAA has approved the project budget, which includes the proposed amount for construction administration services through Hattenburg, Dilley, and Linnell.

Project History

August 15, 2002 Airport Master Plan Approved by City Council that included Phase 1C Apron Expansion, STOL Runway, and Taxiway Extension.

November 1, 2004	City Advertised for Engineering Services RFP for Airport Apron Phase 1C Expansion.
February 1, 2005	RFP scoring completed with Hattenburg, Dilley, and Linnell selected as most qualified to conduct design engineering services and construction administration services for Phase 1C Apron Expansion, STOL Runway, and Taxiway Extension.
February 14, 2005	Contract Award authorized by City Council to Hattenburg, Dilley, and Linnell for engineering design services in the amount of \$263,158 for Apron Phase 1C, STOL Runway, and Taxiway Extension.
March 30, 2006	Bid Opening for base bid (Apron Phase 1C), with additive alternates number 1 (STOL Runway) and number 2 (Taxiway Extension).
April 10, 2006	Contract Award authorized by City Council to Wolverine Supply, Inc. for base bid Apron Phase1C, in the amount of \$2,945,179.
May 2, 2006	Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) authorizes additional funding for STOL runway.

STAFF RECOMMENDED ACTION: In accordance with November 1, 2004 RFP, authorize contract award to Hattenburg, Dilley, and Linnell in the amount of \$299,982 for Airport Apron Phase 1C Construction Administration Services.
