SUMMARY STATEMENT: In accordance with WMC 5.08.120, on April 18, 2006, the City of Wasilla issued Request for Proposal 0621-0-2006/WM for Multi-Use Sports Complex Emergency Kitchen Architectural Services. This RFP was for architectural design services which include engineering studies, surveying, construction plans, permitting, contractor coordination, etc. The actual construction project is proposed to begin in 2007.

Proposals were received from four firms: Architects Alaska, ASCG, Burkhart Croft and Kumin & Associates. Following a thorough review of the proposals to ensure each was responsive and responsible, a committee of three scorers (Recreation and Cultural Service Director, Deputy Director of Public Works, and Purchasing/Contract Officer) scored the proposals. Based upon firm experience, experience of the representative assigned to the City, methodology/approach, communication, proposed fee structure,

and response from two references, Burkhart Croft scored the highest with 263 total points (see attached). Burkhart Croft was the architectural firm for the new MASCOT Transit Building, and prior to establishing Burkhart Croft, Blasé Burkhart and Joanna Croft served a Principal-In-Charge and Project Manager for the original \$14.8M Multi-Use Sports Complex project.

SCOPE OF SERVICES FOR THIS CONTRACT: The City of Wasilla is soliciting proposals from architectural firms for the construction of a commercial kitchen within the Multi-Use Sports Complex (MUSC) facility. This facility is planned to serve as an emergency shelter and the kitchen shall be capable of supporting all emergency functions with the facility, including food service in the event of an emergency. The kitchen will permit the City to partner with the American Red Cross to provide an adequate emergency shelter for the Matanuska Susitna Valley. This project consists of constructing a 3,400 square foot addition to the MUSC. Architectural services include but are not limited to providing building design, regulatory permits, bid specifications, and construction administration. The project is proposed to begin in 2007. The successful proposer will provide the City with final design drawings and bid documents, coordinate with contractors and regulatory agencies for permits, assist the City in the bidding process, and oversee construction. This project is being performed under state guidelines governing grants and loans.

Qualifications, references, methodolody, approach and Cost was worth 90

(1) Architects Alaska qualified for the 2-1/2% local preference, thus their cost estimate of \$176,446 was adjusted to \$172,034.85.

(2) Zero points assigned for communications as the proposal was submitted in narrative form and did not adhere to the format specified in Section 8.7.

(3) The lowest estimate was determined to be reasonable based upon past performance with the City and the detail provided in the cost estimate.

(4) Qualifications scored low because there was nothing in the proposal that addressed Section 4.2.2. concerning qualifications of the person assigned who will directly administer this project. The proposal did identify the individual who would be the key contact and have day to day/overall coordination responsibilities, but did not include his educational background or experience.
