SUMMARY STATEMENT: This contract was advertised on August 8, 2006 with proposals due on September 8, 2006. Three proposals were received and ranked by the evaluation team with the following results:

- 1) Tryck Nyman Hayes, Inc
- 2) DOWL Engineers
- 3) Land Design North

Contract terms were negotiated as outlined on the attached 2-page spreadsheet for a total cost of \$126,678. The City's 5 year CIP shows \$110,000 is planned over three years for this effort. The 5 year plan is proposed to be amended by \$16,678 to meet this contract. The FY07 budget shows \$40,000 is available now to initiate the contract, with \$35,000 available on July 1, 2007 to continue the contract. The initial contract

award is proposed through this action memorandum. Subsequent contract extensions will be subject to City Council approval.

ACTION: Authorize the Mayor to execute an initial contract with Tryck Nyman Hayes, Inc. in the amount of \$40,000 for Parks Master Plan Consulting Services.

1. OVERVIEW OF PROJECT

The City of Wasilla (the "City") is requesting proposals from design firms to prepare two master plans. The first is for a long term plan for existing and future citywide parks. The second is an update to the existing plan for parks related trails and fields for the Multi Use Sports Complex. All services are to be performed by design professionals who hold appropriate licenses and registration under the laws of the State of Alaska.

The City is seeking master plans that will enable public use of the land while preserving the integrity and functionality of all City sites. Key components of the plan will be defining the role that parks should play in the community and will serve as a guide for future parks in Wasilla. The planning will address design as well as program to reflect current uses and future needs of the community.

The City of Wasilla master plan process will engage a significant public process. City staff will assist in designing and coordinating the public process and will work with the project management team to develop community input into the plan. The awarded proposer must be willing and prepared to integrate their work with an open public process. Close coordination between the firm and city personnel will be necessary.

2. BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Wasilla has four parks (Carter, Iditapark, Lakeside and Nunley), five ball fields and approximately ten miles of trails. The City also maintains a fully operational skateboard park, volleyball courts, basketball courts, bmx track, outdoor amphitheater, and children's playgrounds.

The Multi-Use Sports Complex property is located at 1001 S. Mack Drive and is comprised of approximately 59 acres. It currently hosts an indoor hockey rink, indoor soccer field, running track, meeting rooms, ice skate shop and concessions stand. The property has the potential for equestrian trails, bike paths and numerous other outdoor facilities.

3. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A PROPOSAL

A minimum of three (3) years master plan design to meet the unique needs of designing plans based upon multiple input sources is required to submit a proposal. Particular focus will be given to the successful completion of similar projects, and those individuals/companies who are not experienced in this scope of work are asked not to submit as their proposal will be deemed non-responsive. In addition, a demonstrated ability to meet required time schedule is required.

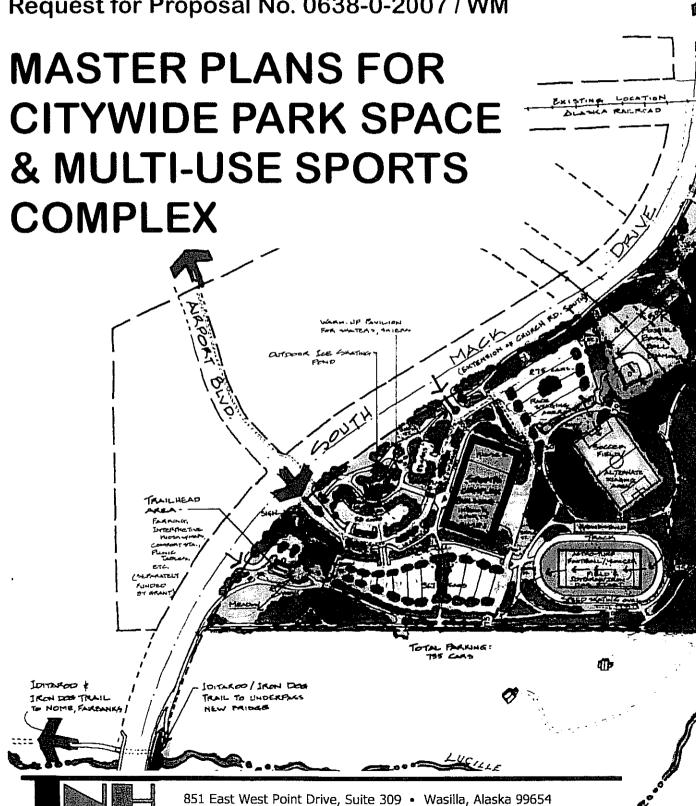

Should the Director of Public Works be unable to negotiate a satisfactory contract with the firm considered to be the highest rated at a fee which he determines to be fair and reasonable, he will undertake negotiations with the should the Director of Public Works be unable to negotiate a satisfactory contract with any of the rated firm, he shall solect and rate additional firms and shall continue negotiations in accordance with this section until as agreement is reached.
