Mayor Stein: Reported he was appointed to the Joint Insurance Board and served on a hearing for the first time today, spoke of the Wasilla Lion's Club lease on the Railroad Depot and will bring something back to Council and Jim Messick proposed doing a utility audit for the City.

12. AUDIENCE COMMENTS:

Mike Chryst: Glad the City hired a police chief within Alaska, it will save on moving costs, glad Mike Carson spoke against using investment pool, commented on the utility audit and stated that nothing should be given to that trough sucking pig, Jim Messick. Mr. Chryst also stated that the attorney had the intellect to get the City into the law suit on sales tax, lets see him get the City out on his own.

<u>Colleen Cottle:</u> Requested that the permits for snow machine races be posted, is concerned about the noise control and safety, does not object to the races, but does object to the noise, mess and sanitation.

Sally Chryst: Commented on the liquor license renewal and transfer policy, feels the reasons are trivial when these businesses are hinged on having that license. Mrs. Chryst stated she feels part of the Council's responsibility is to look at old laws and revise them. She also stated that the City needs to get someone in to decipher the Lake Lucille Study, is also against the investment pool and she is still waiting for someone to revise the bond requirement on contest of elections.

Bill Byers: Commented that all snow machines used for racing are stock according to regulations. Mr. Byers also stated that the reason Lake Lucille is getting polluted is because people are being regulated off the lake. Mr. Byers also stated that the City is the biggest offender of the sign ordinance.

Linda Smith: Brought information on snow machine races and noise levels. Ms. Smith also commented that Mat-Su Motor Mushers is trying to put together a safety course on snow machines and are hoping to use Lake Lucille for this.

Mary Brasie: Stated she does not agree with the investment pool. Mrs. Brasie also stated that her husband had an appropriate saying for people like Polarconsult "Run them out of town on the mule they came in on". Mrs. Brasie also stated they didn't even have a mule when they came into town.
