13. MAYOR, CLERK, AND ATTORNEY COMMENTS

Ms. VanGorder, City Clerk:

 Announced that a written clerk report was not prepared and that Council Member Keller is the March Mat-Su Borough Assembly Representative.

Mr. Klinkner, City Attorney:

- Reported that the billing by subject matter requested by the city clerk will be available soon.
- Invited the council to discuss any budget concerns they may have regarding legal services provided to the city.
- Spoke about his experience in public facility projects and recommended that the council construct the sports complex with General Obligation Bonds.
- Advised that the council proceed with caution on the sports complex.

Mayor Palin:

- Reported that the Iditarod is requesting an additional \$1,800 from the city to provide shuttle bus service for the event.
- Spoke about annexation.
- Announced that a meeting will be held to look at existing vacant space to possibly expand the library.
- Reported that the city received a grant to extend the water main up Lucille Street.

14. AUDIENCE COMMENTS

- Mr. Bill Dau spoke in opposition to the request for rezone of Hodgert Subdivsion.
- Mr. Dave Chappel thanked the attorney for his comments on the sports complex and advised the council to take note of the advice.

15. EXECUTIVE SESSION

No executive session was held.

16. COUNCIL COMMENTS

MOTION:

Council Member Bennett moved to fund an additional \$1,800 to the Iditarod Sled Dog Race for shuttle bus service, provided that the restart is held in Wasilla city limits, for a total amount not to exceed \$6,800 from council contingency. The amount funded will be based on actual costs of the shuttle service.

Discussion followed.

MOTION:

Council Member Keller moved a primary amendment to fund the shuttle bus services contingent upon the Iditarod placing signs on the busses stating that the shuttle service is sponsored by the City of Wasilla.

VOTE:

The primary amendment passed unanimously.

VOTE:

The motion as amended passed unanimously.

Council Member Keller:

- Congratulated the winner of the Jr. Iditarod.
- Requested council compensation information from AML.

Council Member Cottle:

- Does not wish to mix the sports complex issue with the needs of the library.
- Expressed concern over the delay in annexation areas, which have been receiving city water and the loss of revenue to the city.
- Expressed concern with events being conducted on city lakes without the consent of the city.

Council Member Keller:

 Requested that the clerk tentatively schedule a work session with the Mat-Su Borough Assembly to discuss the sports complex. No objection was raised.

17. ADJOURNMENT

The meeting adjourned at 9:43 p.m.
