SUBJECT: Liquor License Renewals

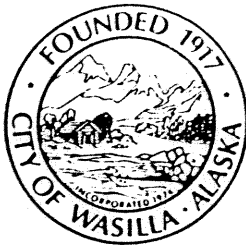
Council Policy 88-5 (attached) outlines certain factors to review before protesting renewal of a liquor license. A report of these factors is attached.



Title: Liquor License Renewals and Transfers


It is Council Policy to protest an application for a liquor license transfer or renewal if any of the following conditions exists:

1. Delinquent Assessments;
2. Delinquent Water or Sewer Utility Payments;
3. Violation of WC 9.04 Business License Ordinance;
4. Violation of WC 11.12 Trash Enclosure Ordinance;
5. Violation of WC 14.04 Abandoned Vehicles and other Property;
6. Encroachments;
7. Violation of MSB 17.43 Wasilla Development Code; or
8. Delinquent Taxes.
