As you are well aware, the Governor made several radical spending cuts in the state budget to balance it. Included in these cuts was the \$20,000 to Wasilla Area Seniors, Inc. for the purchase of a handicapped access vehicle. This specalized vehicle would have served wheel-chair bound citizens of the Greater Wasilla Area who have limited or no alternative transportation other than ambulance.
