RE: Old Wasilla School Use

Assistant Superintendent Martin Laster has indicated that, beginning September 1, 1991, the School District wishes to lease two classrooms for preschool special education programs. Each room would be staffed by two individuals and would serve about a dozen children per class. Children will be transported by bus. Staff will account for four additional vehicles.

Ginny Stocker of Valley Head Start is willing to work with the district and is very supportive of the plan.

If the district follows through with the plan and Council approves, both the Constitution Forum room and the Coast Guard Auxiliary room will have to be vacated. By copy of this memo I am advising the Forum, Rose Palmquist and the Auxiliary that they will have to make other arrangements for space. This includes our engineering records area.

Engineering records may be moved to the unused office at the rear of the Council chambers.

Of course, the district will pay an appropriate lease fee. We may wish to consider giving the entire building back to the district. We will work on those details.
