SUBJECT: Ordinance Serial No. 91-24; Proposed Cemetery

Regulation Changes

This memorandum tries to set forth the proposed changes to Cemetery operations in easy to read language.

- 1. Sets the long term goal of the City someday being out of the Cemetery business other than perpetual maintenance of the existing site. Sets aside an area for a crematorium. Council may not agree with this goal and may wish to go in another direction. Section 13.16.014 reserves a crematorium site.
- 2. Separates all cemetery revenue received from the old Association and from all lot sales since that date into a separate accounting fund. The idea here is to be able to fund perpetual care from interest earnings at the point all lots are sold and eliminate or lessen the need for tax support.

Interest at 5% = \$10,500 annual for operations and maintenance. Section 13.16.025.

- 3. Establishes 50 year reversion back to the City of unused lots. Section 13.16.030(B).
- 4. Prevents profit making by eliminating third party sales. Section 13.16.030(E).
- 5. Establishes disinterment procedures. Section 13.16.030(F).

- 6. Establishes regulations for New Section (West Division). Section 13.16.045.
- 7. Establishes standards for cremation burials. Section $13.16.050\,(B)$.
- 8. Establishes procedures for excavators. Section 13.16.050(C).
- 9. Increases lot prices to \$200.00 from \$125.00. Section 13.16.030(B).

The City of Wasilla hereby assumes 13.16.010 Purpose. Cemetery powers to serve the residents of the City of Wasilla as set forth in AS 29.35.010 and 1.08.050 of this Code. (Ord. W80-S-2)

13.16.020 Exercise of Powers.

- The Mayor shall be responsible for Administration. general administration of the Wasilla Aurora Cemetery and shall promulgate rules and regulations subject to approval by Council.
- B. Financial. All receipts from sales of Cemetery plots shall be deposited in the general fund and appropriations of these funds shall be limited to Cemetery purposes. (Ord. W80-S-2)

13.16.030 Administration.

- A. Any grave plot may be purchased or reserved by purchase, on a first come, first served basis by any person, regardless of race, creed, color or religion, by payment to the City Clerk of the required purchase fee established by Council.
- The purchase fee of each grave lot is One Hundred Twenty Five dollars (\$125.00). The purchase fee of each cemetery plot is Five Hundred dollars (\$500.00).
- The City Administration will continue the designation o the three sections of Aurora Cemetery as the Catholic Section, the Veterans Section, and the General Section. Persons purchasing grave sites shall be informed of the designated areas but may purchase gravplots in any of the the three areas they may choose.
- The City Administration shall maintain permanent record indicating the lot and plot numbers, names and date of burial of al deceased persons interred in Aurora Cemetery. A properly complete State of Alaska Burial Permit shall be provided to the City Clerk b Funeral Directors, Embalmers, Executors, or other persons or agencie lawfully permitted and required to execute Burial Permits. Suc permits shall be permanently maintained on file by the City.

E. Records shall be maintained by the City Administration that indicate pre-purchased or reserved grave lots and plots, the name and address of the purchaser, and the date of purchase. The City shall not authorize the use of pre-purchased or reserved grave plots to anyone other than the purchaser or properly designated representative of the purchaser. A purchaser may relinquish rights to any unused plot and receive full refund of the purchase price. (Ord. 82-28; Ord 85-39)

- $\frac{13.16.040\ \text{Maintenance}}{\text{A.}}$ Headstones, plaques or other memorial markers may be placed on the Westerly end of each Grave plot but shall not extend beyond the width of the grave plot, nor extend more than Thirty (30) inches from the Westerly end of the plot.
- B. Fences, rock outlines or other structures are not permitted except as provided in 13.16.040(A) above. The ground surface of all grave plots shall be maintained to be level and at the same elevation as the surrounding surface.
- C. Planting or placement of flowers on the grave plot within twenty-four (24) inches of a memorial marker or from the Westerly end of the plot is permitted. Planting or placing shrubs, flowering bushes or trees that exceed three (3) feet in height or beyond the longitudinal limits stated herein are prohibited. Plants, flowers, and containers placed beyond the dimensions stated herein for more and containers placed beyond the dimensions stated herein for more that forty-eight (48) hours shall be considered abandoned and may be removed and discarded by City employees.
- D. Structures, other than headstones or memorial plaques that do not comply with the provisions of this section may be removed and discarded by City employees after one hundred twenty (120) days following adoption of this section. (Ord. 82-28)
- 13.16.050 Operation.

 A. The City will contract for excavation and backfill services at the Wasilla Aurora Cemetery. A deposit shall be collected from the requestor. Fees for excavation and backfill services provided by the City shall be actual contractor cost plus twenty five percent (25%) administration fee.
 - Waiver. Hardship cases will be reviewed and in necessary waived at the discretion of the Mayor.
- B. The City will make available written information and instructions for excavation of graves. All grave excavations shall be a minimum of three (3) feet wide, six (6) feet deep, and seven (7 feet six (6) inches long. (Ord. 82-28 1982; 85-39 §2 & 3, 1985)
