SUBJECT: GLENWOOD AVENUE - STATE MUNICIPAL CAPITAL PROJECT MATCHING

GRANT PROGRAM

The City has once again received the State's FY96 application packet for participation in the Municipal Capital Project Matching Grant Program.

Previously, the City has prioritized and identified Glenwood Avenue as a paving (Capital Improvement) project. In last year's State FY95 Capital Project Matching Grant Program application the City requested \$320,000 (with a promise of budgeting \$80,000 as City match) for this estimated \$400,000 paving project.

The City received \$165,435 of the \$320,000 requested and appropriated \$41,531 as its 20% matching share for a total of \$206,966. This left approximately a \$200,000 shortfall (please see Ordinance Serial No. 94-37 attached).

In order to properly fund and continue the Glenwood paving project the City should request an additional \$160,000 from the State's grant program and should budget an additional 20% or \$40,000 in its FY96 CIP budget.

Recommendation: (1) Council approval of the attached Resolution No. 94-70 designating the continuing prioritization of the Glenwood Avenue paving project as it's number 1 Capital Project.

Recommendation: (2) Council approval for Administration to pursue submittal of the application to the State's Municipal Capital Project Matching Grant Program for the additional funding for the paving of Glenwood Avenue.

Recommendation: (3) Council approval for Administration to retain the services of a professional engineer to begin design and construction plans and specs for the reconstruction and paving of Glenwood Avenue.

RESOLUTION NO. WR93-41

A RESOLUTION OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL PERTAINING TO THE FY95 MUNICIPAL CAPITAL PROJECT MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM - AS 37.06.

WHEREAS, the City of Wasilla has been advised that the Office of the Governor may request an allocation of \$320,000 for the City of Wasilla in FY95; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wasilla must commit to funding twenty percent (20%) of capital improvement project costs in order to receive State of Alaska appropriation under the Municipal Capital Project Matching Grant Program.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Wasilla City Council designates the project known as Glenwood Avenue Paving Project as the City's priority project for the FY95 Municipal Capital Project Matching Grant Program - AS 37.06; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Wasilla will contribute the City's local share of \$80,000 to match the State of Alaska appropriation of \$320,000 in order to construct the \$400,000 project.
