SUMMARY:

Council Member Carney would like to present Ordinance Serial Nos. 98-12 and 98-13 to the council for consideration. The only change in the two ordinances is in section 1.20.035(A) (4), relating to the adoption of an ordinance.

The other sections of the both ordinances are identical and define a new ordinance procedure and ordinance format. They also make several grammatical and technical revisions in relation to non-code and emergency ordinances. Lastly, the ordinances repeal four sections of the code which are recodified into sections one and two of the ordinance.

Ordinance Serial No. 98-12 allows for an ordinance to be heard three times. Introduced at one meeting, public hearing at another, with final action to be taken at a later date. Final action will not be taken at the same meeting in which the public hearing is held.

Ordinance Serial No. 98-13 allows for an ordinance to be heard two times. Introduction at one meeting and public hearing at another. Once the public hearing is closed, a motion may be made to take final action. This would allow ordinances of a routine nature to be immediately acted upon, or the more complex issues to be postponed until a later date.
