At the March 9, 1998, council meeting, Council Member Carney requested an amendment to be presented on Ordinance Serial No. 98-13, for council consideration. By an affirmative vote of a majority of the council, the ordinance may be adopted with or without amendments; provided, any amendments do not change the general scope and original intent of the ordinance, or they may reject the ordinance. The correction of typographical or clerical errors may be corrected by the clerk and shall not constitute an amendment within the meaning of this section.
