

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5. PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

a) What is the purpose of the project?

To recondition and pave Spruce Avenue from Wasilla Fishhook to Church Road.

b) What has been accomplished to date?

The project engineering was funded in FY98 by the City to be completed in FY98. Construction of the intersection with Wasilla Fishhook was completed in FY98. The contract for the Wasilla Fishhook to Lucille St. phase was issued in FY99 to be completed in FY99. The Lucille St. to Church St. phase will be engineered and constructed in FY99 and FY2000.

c) How will this grant be used - what exactly will be accomplished at completion of this grant? (After reading this description, DOA should know what activities will need to take place, in what order, and have a strong sense that the grant recipient knows the project and will be able to accomplish the tasks necessary for successful completion. Strip pave Spruce Ave., a City collector road to a width of 24' for about 3 miles from Wasilla Fishhook to Church Rd. The first phase of the project has been engineered and a construction contract issued to be completed in FY99. Phases 2 and 3 will be engineered and constructed in FY99 and FY2000.

1. The City issued a 5.5 million dollar bond in April 1998 for road paving. Two million dollars of these fund have been budgeted for this project.
