**SUMMARY:**

Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities has provided the Planning Office preliminary construction documents to rehabilitate the Palmer-Wasilla Highway. This rehabilitation is anticipated to occur beginning the summer of 2002. The construction begins in the vicinity of Wet Willy's Car Wash and ends near the Tsunami Warning Center in Palmer. The project consists of paving, drainage, signing, striping, illumination and signalization. No additional traffic lanes will be added, however a few additional turn pockets will be provided at some intersections. Documents are available at the Wasilla Planning Office for your review.
