### RESOLUTION NO. WR93-47

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF WASILLA, ALASKA SUPPORTING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FOR THE PUBLIC USE OF BOROUGH SWIMMING POOLS.

WHEREAS, the public swimming programs at Borough pools have been short-funded in FY1994 and now face curtailment of services; and

WHEREAS, pool access is an important and appreciated public service; and

WHEREAS, pool users pay fees which offset about half of the public-use costs of pool operation; and


WHEREAS, Borough citizens may use pools for competition, recreation, conditioning, safety training and therapy; and

WHEREAS, users of pools range in age from infants to senior citizens and represent all economic and social levels; and

WHEREAS, pools offer healthy water activities for youth and families especially during the dark, and winter months.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Wasilla City Council urges the Matanuska-Susitna Borough Administration and Assembly to seek and secure supplemental funding to maintain the present level of service for the public use of Borough swimming pools.
