RESOLUTION NO. WR94-43

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF WASILLA, ALASKA ESTABLISHING CITY PRIORITIES FOR INCLUSION IN THE MATANUSKA-SUSITNA BOROUGH'S SIX (6) YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (CIP) FY1996 - 2001.

WHEREAS, the Matanuska-Susitna Borough exercises areawide powers within and around the City of Wasilla; and

WHEREAS, the property owners in the greater Wasilla area account for nearly half of all taxable land and improvements in the Mat-Su Borough by value; and

WHEREAS, the Mat-Su Borough, both directly and through service areas, plans, designs, contracts for construction and maintains important public roads and public facilities serving the Wasilla area; and

WHEREAS, the Wasilla City Council, Planning Commission, Administration and community residents wish to relate local community priorities for needed capital improvement projects involving Borough roads and public facilities which support the greater Wasilla community; and

WHEREAS, the Wasilla Planning Commission held a public worksession on July 19, 1994 to discuss and rank new and existing capital improvement project priorities for the City of Wasilla;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Wasilla City Council that the following City priorities are established for inclusion in the Matanuska-Susitna Borough's six (6) year Capital Improvement Program (CIP) FY1996-2001:

Matanuska Susitna Borough Roads

1. Seward Meridian Road upgrade, Parks Highway to Bogard Road
2. Seldon Road extension east to Bogard Road (Bogard Road extension)
3. Seward Meridian Road extension from Bogard Road to Seldon Road
4. Vine Road/Hollywood Road paving

Matanuska-Susitna Borough Public Facilities

1. Community Center/Library in Wasilla
2. Indoor Multi-purpose Arena in Wasilla
3. Relocate and Construct New Wasilla Firehall
4. Herning-Teeland-Meade historic restoration

Matanuska-Susitna Borough Schools

1. Wasilla Middle School expansion
2. Mat-Su Alternative School Building renovation
3. School water and sewer connections
