ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 90-36

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AMENDING SECTION 6.24.030 AND 6.24.050 OF THE WASILLA MUNICIPAL CODE, PURCHASING.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Classification. This is a code ordinance and shall become a permanent part of the Wasilla Municipal Code.

SECTION II. Purpose. To amend the purchasing limit in Section 6.24.030(A) and 6.24.050(A)(2).

SECTION III. Amendment. Section 6.24.030(A) and 6.24.050(A)(2) are amended to read as follows:

6.24.030 (A) The Mayor [or his designee] may authorize any department, office or agency of the City to purchase directly certain specified supplies, materials, equipment or contractual services under conditions not less restrictive than those prescribed under this chapter, whenever the purchase price is [Two-hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00)] ONE-THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00) or less.

6.24.050(A)(2) A contractual service, purchase or sale where the known requirements are estimated to be less than Ten-thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) may be made either upon competitive bids in accordance with the subsection A-3 of this section or in the open market, in the discretion of the Mayor, but so far as is practicable shall be based on at least three competitive bids and records as provided in 6.24.180. Purchases made under this subsection with a value of less than [Two-thousand Five-hundred dollars (\$2,500.00)] FIVE-THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00) do not require Council approval. Purchases of [Two-thousand Five-hundred dollars (\$2,500.00)] FIVE-THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00) or more require Council approval.

SECTION IV. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.
