ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 91-19

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA PERTAINING TO THE LEASE OF CITY PROPERTY.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, Wasilla Municipal Code Chapter 7.16 requires that lease of City lands be approved by the City Council ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City of Wasilla desires to lease the lands facilities known as the Bumpus Softball Complex to the Mat-Su Softball Association.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained and enacted by the City of Wasilla, Alaska as follows:

Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.. SECTION I.

The purpose of this ordinance is to SECTION II. Purpose. transfer a temporary leasehold interest in the Bumpus Softball Complex to the Mat-Su Softball Association.

SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 Section RIW, Township 17N, Seward Meridian consisting of approximately 10 acres more or less and containing four (4) softball fields and appurtences thereto; and, the north 200 feet of the NE 1/4, of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 5, R1W, T17N Seward Meridian consisting of approximately three (3) acres and containing a restroom facility and

vehicle parking area.

Provides:

Security checks for portion of year, use of

water well and appurtences. Keys and gate

locks, fertilizer.

Lessee

Provides:

Softball field maintenance, activity

when Lessee is not scheduled, use of

restrooms by American Legion, utility bills,

hold harmless and liability insurance as

required by lease agreement.

Renewal:

Lease may be renewed for additional time periods as mutually agreed on an annual basis, not to exceed 10 years and on such

terms as may be renegotiated.

SECTION IV. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon signature of authorized representatives of Lessor and Lessee on lease agreement and upon adoption of this ordinance by the Wasilla City Council.
