ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 92-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AMENDING CHAPTER 2.20.100, CONFLICT OF INTEREST, OF THE WASILLA MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Wasilla Municipal Code.

SECTION II. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Wasilla Municipal Code 2.20.100 to require Councilmembers with a conflict of interest to become members of the City being offered the same rights and privileges.

SECTION III. Amendments. Section 2.20.100 (E) is added as follows:

E. A Councilmember who has declared a conflict of interest and has been excused by the Mayor from a vote, or a Councilmember who, by majority vote of the Council, has been found to have a conflict of interest, shall also abstain from the discussion and voting on the issue in which there is a conflict of interest except that the Councilmember may speak on the issue as a member of the public.

SECTION IV. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.


