ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 93-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AMENDING SECTION 4.08.030, ELECTION OFFICIALS, OF THE WASILLA MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Wasilla Municipal Code.

SECTION II. Purpose. To amend Section 4.08.030 of the Wasilla Municipal Code by inserting a subsection on relationships between election board members and candidates.

SECTION III. Amendment. Section 4.08.030 Election Organization, is hereby amended as follows:

E. Certain familial relationships may not exist between a candidate and a precinct election judge, election clerk or canvass board member in all city elections. Those familial relationships are:

- (1) mother, mother-in-law, stepmother;
- (2) father, father-in-law, stepfather;
- (3) sister, sister-in-law, stepsister;
- (4) brother, brother-in-law, stepbrother;
- (5) spouse; or
- (6) person sharing the same living quarters.

If the City Clerk knows or learns that any of these relationships exist, he shall have the responsibility and authority to replace the election official involved.

4.12.020 (E) ~~Thirty (30)~~ Fifteen (15) minutes before the closing of the polls, an Election Judge shall proclaim to any persons present the time remaining before the polls close. When the polls are closed, that fact shall be similarly proclaimed, and thereafter no ballots shall be received except those of qualified voters already present at the polls and waiting to vote when polls are closed.

SECTION IV. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.


