ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 94-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AMENDING CHAPTER 4.04, ELECTION GENERAL PROVISIONS, OF THE WASILLA MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Wasilla Municipal Code.

SECTION II. Purpose. To amend the Election Code to reflect a change in the percentage needed in the election of Mayor.

SECTION III. Amendment. Section 4.04.060 Run-off Elections-Mayor's Office is amended as follows:

4.04.060 Run-off Elections-Mayor's Office. A. The City Clerk shall call a run-off election if no candidate receives over 40 fifty percent (40 50%) of the votes cast for the office of Mayor.

SECTION IV. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon the later of the date of adoption by the Council or the date the United States Department of Justice issues its non-objection to the re-enactment or the date by which the United States Department of Justice must object if no objection is issued within the period allowed.
