ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 96-19

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AMENDING CHAPTER 5.10, WASILLA WATER UTILITY OF THE WASILLA MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Wasilla Municipal Code.

SECTION II. Purpose. To amend the existing provision of the Water regulation to delete the requirement for a written contract for the resale of City water. The amendment further states where such water shall be delivered and its priority in the event of a water shortage.

SECTION III. Amendment. Chapter 5.10 of the Wasilla Municipal Code is amended as follows:

Section 5.10.030 E. Resale of Water. Is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:


Section 5.10.030 E. Resale of Water. Resale of water shall be by written permit only if such water has been metered and the person reselling the water is current with respect to all utility billings with the City and that such water is delivered inside the City limits of the City of Wasilla. Resold water may not be transported, via a conduit or piping network, to serve an area or person outside of the city. Once sold, water may be transported anywhere the purchaser wishes to use it. In times of water shortages, resale of water may not be allowed. These times will be announced by the Public Works Department.

SECTION IV. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.


