#### ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 97-40

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE CIP BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1998, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO CARRY OUT SAID BUDGETS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Classification. This is a non-code Ordinance.

<u>SECTION II.</u> Purpose. In accordance with C.W. 6.04.020 the Wasilla City Council hereby adopts the CIP budget for the Fiscal Year 1998, as presented by the Mayor.

<u>SECTION III.</u> Appropriations. There is hereby authorized and appropriated the sum of \$900,611 for CIP expenditures in accordance with the attached budget proposals.
