ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 97-44

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AMENDING CHAPTER 13.06, FIREWORKS CONTROL PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS IN THE WASILLA MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Wasilla Municipal Code.

SECTION II. Purpose. To amend the fine, making a mandatory court appearance and changing the penalty to an infraction.

SECTION III. Amendment. Chapter 13.06.070 is hereby amended as follows:

Penalties for Violations. Every person, firm, corporation, club, association or organization violating this Chapter shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding ~~two~~ONE hundred dollars (\$~~2~~100.00) ~~or by imprisonment not exceeding thirty (30) days, or by both, together with costs of prosecution for each separate offense~~ WITH A MANDATORY COURT APPEARANCE, THE FINE SHALL BE ASSESSED BY THE COURT. IF NEEDED, RESTITUTION SHALL BE ASSESSED BY THE COURT.


SECTION IV. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption.
