ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 97-55

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AMENDING THE FY-98 BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL FUNDS TO THE GENERAL FUND.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

SECTION II. Purpose. The volleyball program was not budgeted in FY98. The program was self-supporting through the fees collected and deposited in a city revenue account. This ordinance will increase the operational budget to cover these expenses and revenues.

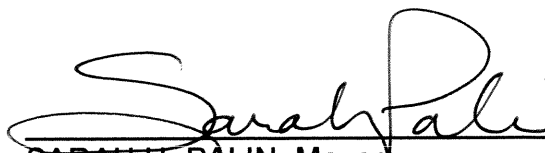

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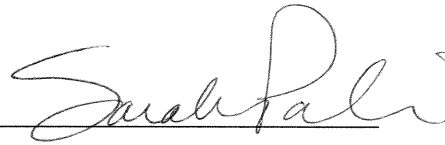
