AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AMENDING CHAPTER 13.08.050, ENFORCEMENT OF CITY PARKS AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY OF WASILLA. ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Wasilla Municipal Code.

To amend the enforcement section of City Parks and SECTION II. Purpose. Recreational Facility Rules.

Chapter 13.08.050, Enforcement of City Parks and SECTION III. Amendment. Recreational Facility Rules is hereby amended as follows:

13,08,050 Enforcement. Non-compliance with parks facilities rules is an infraction and is punishable pursuant to the procedures and penalties set forth in WMC 1.24.010 (providing for fines up to \$1,000.00)as explained by signs or by the City of Wasilla law enforcement personnel is an infraction and punishable by a fine of up to two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00). An infraction requires a mandatory court appearance with appropriate fines, restitution and/or community work service being set by the presiding judge.

SECTION IV. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this ordinance and the application to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION V. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.
