# CITY OF WASILLA ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 98-27(SUBSTITUTE)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING CHAPTER 13.60, SKATEBOARDING.

**Section 1.** Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Wasilla Municipal Code.

**Section 2.** Adoption of chapter. Chapter 13.60, Skateboarding, is hereby adopted to read as follows:

## **13.60.010 DEFINITIONS**

- (A) In this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:
- (1) "Bike Path" means any recreational trail or path including traffic lanes or adjacent paths set aside upon a roadway, that has been designated for travel by bicycles, pedestrians or other non-motorized modes of travel.
- (2) "Sidewalk" means that portion of a street between the curblines, or the lateral lines of a roadway, and the adjacent property lines, intended for the use of pedestrians.
- (3) "Skateboard" means a device with wheels for riding upon, usually standing, including, without limitations, skateboards of all types.

## 13.60.020 OPERATION PROHIBITED IN CERTAIN AREAS.

It is unlawful for any person to operate or ride a skateboard on any public or private property where signs are posted prohibiting such use.

## 13.60.030 OPERATION PERMITTED.

(A) Skateboards are permitted on public sidewalks, parks, and bike paths. The skateboard operator shall yield the right-of-way to any pedestrian

using public property, and shall not otherwise endanger or interfere with pedestrian traffic.

- (B) The rules relating to pedestrians crossing streets shall apply to persons crossing a street on a skateboard.
  - (C) No person shall:
- (1) Ride a skateboard on any public property without exercising due care for the safety of other persons.
- (2) Attach to any moving motorized vehicle while riding a skateboard.

## 13.60.040 PENALTY.

- (A) Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this chapter shall be fined the following:
- (1) For the first offense a \$35 fine shall be paid and the skateboard may be confiscated for 10 days.
- (2) For the second offense a \$70 fine shall be paid and the skateboard may be confiscated for 30 days.
- (3) For the third offense a \$100 fine shall be paid and the skateboard shall be permanently confiscated.
- (B) Upon the discretion of the court, community work service may be performed in lieu of payment of the fine.
- (C) The Wasilla City Police Department may confiscate skateboards as authorized in this section.
- (D) In cases involving a contested citation, a confiscated skateboard shall be held as evidence, not released until a mandated court appearance is satisfied, and dealt with as ordered by the court.
- **Section 4. Effective date.** This ordinance shall become effective upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.
