CITY OF WASILLA ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 98-32

AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL DIRECTING THE CITY CLERK TO SUBMIT THE QUESTION OF A MANAGER PLAN OF GOVERNMENT TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY AT THE OCTOBER 6, 1998 REGULAR CITY ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the Wasilla City Council desires to place the adoption of a city manager plan before the voters of Wasilla in accord with AS 29.20.470.

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Submission to voters. The City Clerk shall submit the following proposition to the qualified voters of the city at the regular election of October 6, 1998. The proposition must receive an affirmative vote from a majority of the qualified voters voting on the question to be approved. The proposition shall read substantially in the following form:

Proposition No. 1 MANAGER PLAN OF GOVERNMENT

"Shall a Manager Plan of Government be adopted for the City of Wasilla, with the Manager Plan to be adopted by ordinance within 60 days of the certification of the results of this election?"

Section 3. Proposition. The proposition shall be printed on a ballot and the following words shall be added as appropriate and next to a square provided for marking the ballot for voting by hand or machine:

PROPOSITION NO. 1 YES NO

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption the Wasilla City Council.
