CITY OF WASILLA ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 99-30

AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL REPEALING WMC 2.45, PUBLIC SAFETY DIRECTOR. AND AMENDING WMC 3.35.010(B), EXEMPT EMPLOYEES, TO ELIMINATE THE POSITION OF PUBLIC SAFETY DIRECTOR.

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become a part of the Wasilla Municipal Code.

Section 2. Repeal of chapter. WMC 2.45, Public Safety Director, is hereby repealed in its entirety:

CHAPTER 2.45: PUBLIC SAFETY DIRECTOR

Section: 2.45.010 Appointment.

2.45.020 Duties.

2.45.010 Appointment.

The public safety director shall be appointed by the mayor and serves at the pleasure of the mayor and is an exempt, at-will employee.

2.45.020 Duties.

The public safety director reports to the mayor on all public safety matters. The position is responsible for strategic planning in the area of public safety; coordinates with all emergency services serving the city; and exercises authority over the Wasilla Police Department and any future public safety entities.

Section 3. Amendment of subsection. WMC 3.35.010(B), Exempt Employees, is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (B) The following positions are exempt:
 - (1) Deputy Administrator;
 - (2) City Clerk;
 - (3) City Attorney;
 - (4) Chief of Police;
 - (5) Library Director;

- (6) Museum Director;
- (7) Finance Director; and
- (8) Public Works Director[;].
- (9) [PUBLIC SAFETY DIRECTOR.]

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption of the Wasilla City Council.
