

**CITY OF WASILLA
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 99-47**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL AMENDING WMC 16.43.706(D)(2) RELATING TO MINIMUM PARKING AND PAVING REQUIREMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become part of the Wasilla Municipal Code.

Section 2. Amendment of Section. WMC 16.43.706(D)(2), Parking, is hereby amended to read as follows:

[EXCLUDING] All required off-street parking and aisles other than residential uses less than five dwelling units and temporary uses [, ALL REQUIRED OFF-STREET PARKING AREAS, INCLUDING INGRESS AND EGRESS ROUTES,] shall be surfaced with at least two inches of hot bituminous pavement or a durable surface that is designated to control dust and able to bear the weight of the traffic as approved by the public works director. Developments located on property not zoned commercial, under 5,000 square feet and with no access to a paved road are exempt from this minimum standard. After a roadway is paved, required parking, aisles, and driveways shall be paved, or have an approved durable surface applied within twelve months after the roadway is paved [APPROVED BY THE MAYOR OR DESIGNEE THAT IS DESIGNED TO CONTROL DUST AND ABLE TO BEAR THE WEIGHT OF EXPECTED TRAFFIC].

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption of the Wasilla City Council.
