

**CITY OF WASILLA
ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 99-51**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AMENDING THE FY00 BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE GENERAL, WATER AND SEWER CIP FUNDS.
