CITY OF WASILLA ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 00-14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL ADOPTING WMC 1.08.045, MUNICIPAL POWERS, FACILITIES AND SERVICES AND REPEALING WMC 1.08.050, MUNICIPAL FACILITIES AND SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED:

- * **Section 1. Classification.** This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become part of the city code.
- * **Section 2. Adoption of chapter.** WMC 1.08.045, is hereby adopted to read as follows:

1.08.045 MUNICIPAL POWERS, FACILITIES AND SERVICES.

- (A) The city may exercise any municipal power not otherwise prohibited by law.
- (B) The city is authorized to provide public facilities and services, which shall included, but not be limited to:
- (1) Streets, roads, sidewalks, paths and trails, including related water drainage, landscaping, and parking;
 - (2) Sewers and sewage treatment;
 - (3) Water treatment and distribution, including fire hydrants;
 - (4) Utility easements;
 - (5) Police protection and jails;
 - (6) Parks, playgrounds, sports fields and recreation;
- (7) Community centers, libraries, museums, and all other public buildings and grounds;
 - (8) Airports and aviation;
 - (9) Public transportation;
 - (10) Cemeteries;

- (11) Planning and land use;
- (12) Housing and urban renewal, rehabilitation and development;
- (13) Economic and tourism development;
- (14) Watercourse and flood control;
- (15) Environmental and wetlands protection;
- (16) Wildlife conservation and protection; and
- (17) Any other facility or service deemed necessary or appropriate by the council.
- (C) The provision of any public facility or service is subject to council approval and the availability of funds.
- (D) This section is to be broadly interpreted to authorize all acts related to the providing of any public service or facility which the city is not prohibited by law from providing.
- **Section 3. Repeal of chapter.** WMC 1.08.050, Municipal Facilities and Services, is hereby repealed in its entirety: [1.08.050 MUNICIPAL FACILITIES AND SERVICES.
- (A) THE CITY OF WASILLA WILL EXERCISE THE POWERS NECESSARY TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING PUBLIC FACILITIES AND SERVICES SUBJECT TO COUNCIL APPROVAL AND FUNDS AVAILABLE.
 - (1) STREETS AND SIDEWALKS;
 - (2) SEWERS AND SEWAGE TREATMENT FACILITIES;
 - (3) HARBORS, WHARVES, AND OTHER MARINE FACILITIES;
 - (4) WATERCOURSE AND FLOOD CONTROL FACILITIES;
 - (5) HEALTH SERVICES AND HOSPITAL FACILITIES;
 - (6) CEMETERIES;
 - (7) POLICE PROTECTION AND JAIL FACILITIES;
 - (8) COLD STORAGE PLANTS;
 - (9) TELEPHONE SYSTEMS;
 - (10) LIGHT, POWER AND HEAT;
 - (11) WATER;
 - (12) TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS;

- (13) COMMUNITY CENTERS;
- (14) LIBRARIES;
- (15) PLANNING AND LAND-USE POWERS
- (16) AIRPORT AND AVIATION FACILITIES;
- (17) GARBAGE AND SOLID-WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICE AND FACILITIES SUBJECT TO 33 OF THIS CHAPTER;
 - (18) FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE AND FACILITIES;
 - (19) PARKING AND PARKING FACILITIES;
- (20) HOUSING & URBAN RENEWAL, REHABILITATION & DEVELOPMENT;
 - (21) MUSEUMS;
 - (22) CONSUMER PROTECTION;
 - (23) ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.]
- * Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption of the Wasilla City Council.

SUMMARY:

WMC 1.08.050 has been revised to be consistent with Title 29, and to reflect the powers that the city is now or will be exercising. As the city develops, this code section may be amended if additional powers and facilities need be listed.

The powers which are not exercised by the city, or which are not applicable to the city, have been deleted. For example, telephone, electricity, and solid waste and garbage collection are not being done by the city. The city does not have a consumer protection department. Wharves, docks and cold storage facilities apply to an ocean port city with a fishing industry.

This ordinance is being revised as part of the re-codification process, which is now in process.
