ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 00-62**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AMENDING THE FY01 BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING FUNDS TO THE GENERAL FUND FROM THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL BOARD TO REIMBURSE CITY FOR WAGES TO INCREASE ALCOHOL ENFORCEMENT TARGETING THE 14-20 AGE GROUP.

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. To reimburse city for police wages and benefits so that the Police Department can increase alcohol enforcement efforts targeting the 14-20 age group.

Section 3. Appropriation. Funds are appropriated to the following fund:



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

The goal of this project is to reduce underage alcohol consumption by increasing enforcement efforts at the consumer level (minors who consume alcohol) and at the distribution level (alcohol sales locations). To that end the Wasilla Police Department will comply with the following:

- (1) Designate and train, with the assistance of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, special assignment officers to increase alcohol enforcement targeting the 14-20 age groups.
- (2) To begin increased enforcement by increasing checks on alcohol sales locations for the four-hour period following the end of the school day.
- (3) To patrol public areas where underage persons are known to consume alcoholic beverages, such as parks, malls, dragging main streets, parking lots, teen clubs, etc. and to cite any minors apprehended consuming or possessing alcoholic beverages.
- (4) To use minor agents to send to licensed premises to purchase alcoholic beverages. Any violations of liquor laws will be handled by the ABC Board Investigators.
- (5) To use minor agents outside liquor stores to solicit adults to purchase alcoholic beverages for them. Violators will be cited for a criminal offense of adults furnishing alcohol to minors.
- (6) To gain intelligence about "rave parties" or other underage drinking parties and to interdict and cite any underage alcohol consumption and any adults providing alcoholic beverages at the parties or the site for illicit drug and alcohol use by minors.
- (7) To increase patrols past curfew and make contact with minors for alcohol consumption and curfew violations based upon observations by special assignment officers.
- (8) To supply buys funds for special operations, which will be re-imbursed by the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board.
- (9) To provide workers' compensation insurance, liability insurance for automobiles used for this grant, and general liability insurance. To be in compliance with all state and federal labor laws.
- (10) Provide financial records of all transactions and expenses related to the grant activities of personnel working this special assignment.

- (11) To track the performance of special personnel in achieving the above goals and develop a regular monthly record of all activities and enforcement actions taken and to supply those records to the ABC Board.
- (12) To cooperate with the ABC Board in designing enforcement activities.
- (13) The Wasilla Police Department will not exceed \$ 6,000.00 during the duration of this project, which will end June 30, 2001.
