AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA AMENDING THE FY 02 BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND'S FUND BALANCE IN ORDER TO FUND THE PURCHASE OF SECURITY GATES FOR THE AIRPORT.

BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. To appropriate additional funds to the fund the purchase of security gates for the Airport.

Section 3. Appropriation. Funds are appropriated to the following fund:



SUBJECT: Supplemental Appropriation To FY 2002 Capital Budget To Purchase Airport Electronic Security Gates

SUMMARY:

When the FY 2002 Capital Budget was prepared, full funding for electronic security gates for the airport was inadvertently left out. Ordinance 01-50 will allow this project to be fully funded for a total of \$25,000, the estimated cost for this project.


During the past year, there have been several acts of theft and vandalism at the airport. Because there is no round-the-clock monitoring of the airport grounds, a security gate that allows twenty-four hour access to the airport by pilots and other authorized people is the most cost effective alternative.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

It is recommended that Ordinance 01-50 be approved to fully fund the installation of electronic security gates at the airport.
