Water Enterprise Fund



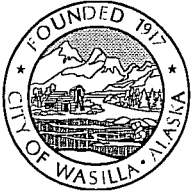

**SUMMARY:** \$30,000 was appropriated on February 25, 2002 to repair the Richmond Hills Booster Station. This booster station supplies the East Parks Highway corridor with water. \$24,400 has been spent to date repairing the booster station. The balance (\$5,600) will lapse at the end of the fiscal year. The balance will be needed to complete the repairs in July.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** \$5,600

**RECOMMENDED ACTION:** Council is requested to authorize the appropriation in the amount of \$5,600 to repair the Richmond Hills Booster Station.
