Section 3. Appropriation. Funds are appropriated to the following fund:



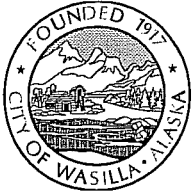

SUMMARY: The City recently received \$94,000 from the Mat-Su Borough that reimbursed the City for a portion of the paving it completed last year, as part of the Borough's annual TORA program. The administration is proposing to use \$81,000 of this funding for additional road upgrading. The funding will be used for drainage improvements, chipseal, and paving.

FISCAL IMPACT: \$81,000 11-55-473-841-01
