AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WASILLA, ALASKA TO APPROVE AND ACCEPT THE BICYCLE/PEDESTRIAN SAFETY MINI GRANT FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES AND AMEND THE FY-03 BUDGET BY AN INCREASE OF \$1,144.

Section 1. Classification. This is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. To approve and accept the Bicycle/Pedestrian Safety Mini Grant from the State Department of Transportation and Public Facilities.

General Fund Balance: \$ 394


Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Wasilla City Council.

SUMMARY: The State of Alaska, Department of Transportation & Public Facilities, Alaska Highway Safety Office has approved a Mini-Grant to the City Parks Department for the 2003 Valley Bicycle Rodeo to be held Saturday, May 17, at Cottonwood Creek Mall in Wasilla. The goal of the bike rodeo is to encourage helmet usage among local bike riders and to teach and practice appropriate bicycle safety, thereby reducing the number of deaths and serious injuries resulting from bicycle crashes.

Sponsoring agencies include: City of Wasilla, Valley Hospital, Central Mat-Su Fire Department, Wasilla Rotary Club, Girl Scouts, Boy Scouts, Cottonwood Creek Mall and Wasilla Police.

One hundred bicycle helmets, 100 safety strobe lights and two bikes including locks, tire pumps and tire kits will be purchased to give to participants as incentives.
