Section 3. Appropriation. Funds are appropriated to the following fund:





SUMMARY STATEMENT:

This ordinance appropriates funds that have been previously designated for sewer grants. The grants assist residential sewer connections in the amount of \$4,000 per connection. Public Works has received six grant applications this fiscal year. The balance of the appropriation will be eligible for future grant applications. This grant pays between 25-50 percent of a typical residential sewer connection.
