



**SUMMARY STATEMENT:**

This Resolution will appropriate funds from the General Fund into the Library Property Operating fund to pay for professional services required for dust abatement at the Wasilla Public Library. It has been determined that the recent remodeling project has caused significant dust problems inside the building and that these services are necessary for the health and safety of employees and patrons.

This appropriation includes air quality monitoring by the same firm that provided the initial air quality assessment for the Library Remodel project, and a final air quality report will be submitted to the mayor.
