- \* Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become part of the city code.
- \* **Section 2. Amendment of section.** WMC 5.40.040, Dedication of abandoned, stolen, or found bicycles, is amended to read as follows:

Any bicycle in the possession of the police department not claimed for <u>ninety</u> [TEN (10)] days, and for which the owner is not known, may be dedicated to public use or benefit <u>as determined by the mayor or his or her designee</u> [IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 5.40.030(B) AFTER PROPER NOTIFICATION AS OUTLINED IN SECTION 5.40.020].

\* Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption of the Wasilla City Council.
