AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY-04 BUDGET BY REDUCING THE EPA GRANT BUDGET FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE SOUTH MACK DRIVE WATER MAIN EXTENSION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$82,206.58.

* **Section 1. Classification.** This is a non-code ordinance.

* **Section 2. Purpose.** To reduce the EPA grant budget for the construction of the South Mack Drive Water Main Extension to reflect the amount of funds not required for the project.

* **Section 3. Reduction.** Funds are reduced from the following funds:

320-4300-331.31-09 (\$82,206.58)


* **Section 5 Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption of the Wasilla City Council.






