AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY-04 BUDGET BY APPROPRIATING FUNDS FROM THE INSTITUTE OF MUSEUM AND LIBRARY SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7,890 FOR THE 2004 CONSERVATION ASSESSMENT PROGRAM GRANT.

* **Section 1. Classification.** This is a non-code ordinance.

* **Section 2. Authority.** To amend the FY-04 Museum by appropriating funds from the Institute of Museum and Library Services for the 2004 Conservation Assessment Program Grant. Grant Match of \$610 will be transferred from supplies to the grant expenditure account.

* **Section 3. Appropriation.** Funds are appropriated to the following fund:


* **Section 4. Source of Funds.**



SUMMARY STATEMENT:

The Museum applied for and received a grant from the Institute of Museum and Library Services in the amount of \$7,890. The City has a required grant match of \$610. Funds will be used to pay the Institute of Museum and Library Services a \$1,350 administrative fee and to pay for an Architectural Conservator and a Collections' Conservator to perform an assessment of the Museum. Any remaining funds may be used to make the necessary upgrades and changes recommended by the conservators.
