**AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL REPEALING WMC 2.60.020, OFFICERS, RELATING TO THE ELECTION OF OFFICERS FOR THE WASILLA PLANNING COMMISSION.**

\* **Section 1. Classification.** This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become part of the city code.

\* **Section 2. Amendment of section.** WMC 2.60.020, is repealed in its entirety as follows:

[2.60.020 OFFICERS

A. THE COMMISSION SHALL HAVE A CHAIRPERSON AND A VICE-CHAIRPERSON.

B. OFFICERS SHALL BE ELECTED AT THE FIRST REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSION FOLLOWING THE MEETING AT WHICH ONE OR MORE NEWLY APPOINTED OR RE-APPOINTED COMMISSIONER IS SEATED. THE COMMISSION SHALL ELECT ITS OFFICERS NOT LATER THAN THE LAST REGULAR MEETING IN FEBRUARY.]

\* **Section 3. Effective date.** This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption of the Wasilla City Council.






**SUMMARY STATEMENT:** This ordinance is presented for house keeping purposes. Election of officers for all city boards and commissions is addressed in WMC 2.44.070; therefore 2.60.020 is redundant and should be removed from the code.

WMC 2.44.070, Officers, reads as follows:

2.44.070 Officers.

A. Each commission shall have a chairperson and a vice-chairperson. Officers shall be elected by a majority of the commission members for a term of one year. Election of officers shall be the first order of business at any time that an officer's seat is not filled.

B. The duties of the chairperson shall be to preside at all commission meetings, to call meetings and to perform other duties as required.

C. The duties of the vice-chairperson shall be to perform the duties of the chairperson in the chairperson's absence.
