



SUMMARY STATEMENT: This ordinance appropriates \$90,000 from the General Fund that is anticipated to be allocated to the Capital Reserve Fund in January 2005. This funding will allow the Airport Apron Phase 1C design to be completed in time for the project to be bid during the 2005 construction season. Construction of the phase 1C apron will be funded 95 percent through an FAA grant.
