CITY OF WASILLA ORDINANCE SERIAL NO. 05-40(AM)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL AMENDING WMC 3.65.020.F, COVERAGE, USE, ACCRUAL, AND OTHER ASPECTS OF PAID TIME OFF ("PTO") TO PROVIDE FOR THE ACCRUAL OF PTO DURING ANY AUTHORIZED, UNPAID LEAVE.

WHEREAS the City wishes to allow paid time off ("PTO") to accrue during all approved unpaid leaves of absence.

- Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature and shall become part of the city code.
- Section 2. Amendment of section. WMC Section 3.65.020.F, Coverage, use, accrual, and other aspects of PTO, is amended as follows:
- PTO shall not accrue during any pay period in which an employee is F. absent without written authorization of the department head or the mayor [,OR] . PTO shall accrue during any pay period in which an employee is absent with written authorization, but is in non-paid status for not more than seven calendar days or 40 work hours within a calendar year.
- Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption of the Wasilla City Council.
