**AN ORDINANCE OF THE WASILLA CITY COUNCIL AMENDING THE FY06 POLICE DEPARTMENT BUDGET BY ACCEPTING THE STATE OF ALASKA COMMERCE COMMUNITY & ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$70,000 AND REDUCING THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE BYRNE GRANT BY \$58,371 TO THE AWARD AMOUNT OF \$12,464.**

**Section 1. Classification.** This is a non-code ordinance.

**Section 2. Purpose.** Amend the FY06 Police department budget by accepting the State of Alaska Commerce Community & Economic Development grant and reducing the Department of Justice Byrne Grant to the award amount. Half of the Department of Justice Byrne Grant will be shared with the City of Palmer Police Department for their Investigation Unit.

**Section 3. Appropriation.** Funds are appropriated to the following fund:


**Section 4. Source of Funds.**

**SUMMARY STATEMENT:**

This ordinance is to adjust the funding for the City's drug enforcement investigator and to recognize a pass-thru grant to the City of Palmer to help fund their drug enforcement investigator. The City originally identified the funding for the investigator to be from a grant issued through the Department of Justice for the amount of \$70,835. In the final combination of funding for the investigator, \$70,000 of the investigator's funding will be from a State of Alaska Commerce Community & Economic Development grant and additional \$6,232 from a Department of Justice Byrne grant. Additionally, the City of Wasilla will receive \$6,232 of grant monies from the Department of Justice (total grant \$12,464) to be passed through to the City of Palmer for assisting in funding of their cost for drug enforcement investigator (see attached agreement).
